Governor Ferdinand Y. Miclat is one of two incumbent Governors who are CPA-lawyers, obtaining his accountancy degree from the Tarlac State University and his law degree from the Far Eastern University. Gov. Ferdie's professional career spans service in the academe, politics and governance, and private sector involvement.

At 46 years of age, he has already held the positions of President of the IBP Tarlac Chapter (2005-2007), President of the Rotary Club of Tarlac Metro (2002-2003), Assistant Governor of Rotary District 3790 (2005-2006), Director of the Provincial Blood Council of the Philippine National Red Cross in his home province, and private sector representative of the Boy Scouts of the Philippines, Tarlac Council.

He has likewise served as Faculty Member of the College of Business Administration and the College of Law of the Tarlac State University. Gov. Ferdie once served as Branch Clerk of Court of Tarlac City's RTC Branch 63, and City Councilor from 2001-2004, effectively rounding out his involvement in the public sphere.
